

“Uzbekistan Airways” air company increases frequency of flights to Delhi

Given the high passenger demand, starting from December 24, 2021, “Uzbekistan Airways” will operate a second frequency of flights to and from the capital of India.

Now flights on Tashkent - Delhi – Tashkent route will be operated twice a week - on Tuesdays and Fridays according to the schedule. Flights on these days will be operated according to the following traffic schedule (local time):

- HY 421 Tashkent - Delhi: departure at 02.15, arrival at 05.45;
- HY 422 Delhi - Tashkent: departure at 08.15, arrival at 10.45.

The cost of air tickets on this route in one direction starts from 2 million 282 850 soums (without luggage) and from 2 million 612 459 soums (with luggage), as well as round-trip air tickets starts from 3 million 922 586 soums (without luggage) and 4 million 435 311 soums (with luggage).

Air tickets can be purchased on the official website of the airline, at the Uzbekistan Airways Sales branch, or from the airline's agents.

We remind you that when buying an air ticket through the official website of the airline, a 3% discount is provided.
