

TRAVEL SAFE With Lithium Batteries

1. PACK LIGHT

Carry only those devices and batteries that are truly necessary. A maximum of two spare batteries is permitted per passenger.

2. KEEP DEVICES WITH YOU

Always carry electronic devices on your person or in carry-on baggage placed under the seat in front of you.

3. USE PROPERLY

Do not charge spare batteries using power sources installed in the seat or on board. Do not use them to charge or power other portable electronic devices during taxiing, takeoff, and landing.

4. STAY ALERT

If a device is hot, smoking or damaged, inform the crew immediately.

5. CHECK BATTERY CAPACITY

Drones and devices with larger batteries must be cleared with airlines before travel

6. GATE CHECK REMINDER

If you are asked to check in your carry-on baggage at the boarding gate or onboard the aircraft, please remove all electronic devices in advance and keep them with you in the cabin.

7. PROTECT LOOSE BATTERIES

If you are carrying spare batteries, ensure the terminals are covered with tape, or keep them in the original packaging.

8. CHECK WITH YOUR AIRLINE

Every airline has different rules, so always check in advance of your travel.
